Main Magnolia Competition

The Quicke Cup for the best exhibit will be presented.

SCHEDULE

- Class 1. SINGLE BLOOM, any species or hybrid, EXCEPT M. kobus, M. stellata, M. x loebneri or M. acuminata species and hybrids.
- Class 2. SINGLE SPRAY, any species or hybrid, EXCEPT M. kobus, M. stellata, M. x loebneri or M. acuminata species and hybrids.
- Class 3. SINGLE BLOOM, M. kobus, M. stellata or M. x loebneri species or hybrids.
- Class 4. SINGLE SPRAY, M. kobus, M. stellata or M. x loebneri species or hybrids.
- Class 5. SINGLE BLOOM, M. acuminata species or hybrids.
- Class 6. SINGLE SPRAY, M. acuminata species or hybrids.
- Class 7. VASE of Magnolia, any species or hybrid.
- Class 8. SINGLE SPRAY of Michelia/Manglietia species or hybrids.

Main Camellia Competition

The Williams Challenge Trophy for the best exhibit will be presented. The Trewithen Cup for the most points awarded will be presented.

SCHEDULE

Camellia, single blooms

- Class 1. Camellia japonica, any cultivar, one bloom.
- Class 2. *C. japonica*, any three cultivars, one bloom of each, 3 vases.
- Class 3. *Camellia reticulata*, any cultivar or hybrid of which *C. reticulata* is a parent, one bloom

- Class 4. *Camellia* x *williamsii*, any cultivar, one bloom.
- Class 5. Camellia x williamsii, any three cultivars, one bloom of each, 3 vases.
- Class 6. Any six different camellias, one bloom of each, 6 vases
- Class 7. Any intermediate camellia, one bloom.

 (Intermediate camellias are those who normal blooms are more than 6cm and less than 8cm across ie not uncharacteristically small or large.)
- Class 8. Any miniature camellia, one bloom.

 (Miniature camellias are those whose normal blooms are less than 6cm across ie not uncharacteristically small blooms of a larger flowered variety.)
- Class 9. Any species or cultivar not included above, one bloom
- Class 10. Three blooms of the same cultivar.

Camellia sprays & vases

Each spray or vase must not exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ in height from top of vase nor $2\frac{1}{2}$ in overall width.

- Class 11. Any Camellia japonica cultivar, one spray
- Class 12. Any Camellia x williamsii cultivar, one spray
- Class 13. Any camellia, not eligible for classes 11 and 12, one spray
- Class 14. An arrangement of camellias shown for effect, one vase (standard competition vase)

Floral Display Competition

The Colin & Mary Brown Cup for the best exhibit will be presented.

SCHEDULE

(Foliage from other genera may be used for infill but <u>not</u> flowers)

(No floral foam to be used, please.)

- Class 1. A formal dining table arrangement of rhododendrons *and/or* camellias *and/or* magnolias shown for effect and not exceeding 21 inches long, 12 inches wide and 12 inches high.
- Class 2. A formal arrangement in a vase, urn or basket of rhododendrons *and /or* camellias *and/or* magnolias shown for effect and not exceeding 36 inches x 36 inches x 36 inches high.

- Class 3. An informal arrangement in a vase, urn or basket of rhododendrons *and /or* camellias *and/or* magnolias shown for effect and not exceeding 36 inches x 36 inches x 36 inches high.
- Class 4. A miniature arrangement of rhododendrons and/or camellias and/or magnolias shown for effect and not exceeding 9 inches x 9 inches x 9 inches.
