EXTRACT FROM THE SOCIETY'S REGULATIONS

“In order to be satisfied that the conditions governing competitive exhibits are fulfilled, the Council reserves the right to visit by commission, before or after a show, gardens from which plants, flowers, fruit or vegetables have been entered for competition.”

No exhibitor may show the same species, variety or hybrid (as the case may be) in two exhibits in the same class.

Class	Number of Entries	Description (For full particulars, see Schedule)
1.		Any elepidote species, one truss.
2.		Any elepidote species, one spray (not exceeding 36" from the top of the vase).
3.		Any lepidote species, one spray (not exceeding 24" from the top of the vase).
4.		Any elepidote hybrid, one truss.
5.		Three elepidote hybrids, one truss of each.
6.		Any elepidote hybrid, one spray (not exceeding 36" from the top of the vase).
7.		Any <i>Rhododendron yakushimanum</i> cultivar or hybrid, one truss.
8.		Any lepidote hybrid, one spray (not exceeding 24" from the top of the vase).
9.		Any tender species or hybrid (grown under glass or otherwise) from subgenus <i>Vireya</i> or from subsections <i>Edgeworthia</i> or <i>Maddenia</i> of section <i>Rhododendron</i> , one truss or spray (not exceeding 24" from the top of the vase).
10.		Any deciduous azalea species or hybrid, one spray (not exceeding 36" from the top of the vase).
11.		Any evergreen azalea species or hybrid, one spray (not exceeding 36" from the top of the vase).
12.		Any rhododendron or azalea cultivar, raised from seed by the exhibitor, one truss or spray.
13.		A display of rhododendron foliage from a range of species, arranged to demonstrate the way foliage is important and a major attraction throughout the seasons. Arranged for decorative effect in a vase.
14.		Any companion plant, one potted species or hybrid.
15.		Any rhododendron, one truss, shown by a first time exhibitor or any exhibitor who has not won a prize in the last five years at a previous RHS Rhododendron Competition.
