SCHEDULE

- Class 1. THREE DIFFERENT SPECIES, HYBRIDS OR CULTIVARS,
three vases to be displayed on two tiers.
(A vase may consist of several sprays)
- Class 2. ONE SPECIES, HYBRID OR CULTIVAR, one vase.
(A vase may consist of several sprays)
- Class 3. ANY SPECIES, HYBRID OR CULTIVAR, one single bloom in a small vase.
- Class 4. ANY THREE DIFFERENT SPECIES, HYBRIDS OR CULTIVARS,
one single bloom of each in three small vases.

SCHEDULE

- Class 1. ANY THREE SPECIES, one truss of each.
- Class 2. ANY SPECIES, one truss.
- Class 3. ANY SPECIES, one spray or branch with one or more than one truss not exceeding 30" from the top of the vase. Exhibits over 24" in width will not on that account gain extra marks.
- Class 4. ANY SPECIES OF subsect. ARBOREA, one truss.

- Class 5. ANY SPECIES OF subject. ARGYROPHYLLA, one truss.
- Class 6. ANY SPECIES OF subject. BARBATA subject. GLISCHRA or subject. MACULIFERA, one truss.
- Class 7. ANY SPECIES OF subject. FALCONERA or subject. GRANDIA, one truss.
- Class 8. ANY SPECIES OF subject. FORTUNEA, one truss.
- Class 9. ANY SPECIES OF subject. NERIIFLORA, one truss.
- Class 10. ANY SPECIES OF subject. NERIIFLORA one spray not exceeding 12" from the top of the vase.
- Class 11. ANY SPECIES OF subject. CAMPYLOCARPA or subject. THOMSONIA, one truss.
- Class 12. ANY SPECIES OF subject. GLAUCA or subject. LAPPONICA, one spray not exceeding 12" from the top of the vase.
- Class 13. ANY SPECIES OF subject. TRIFLORA or subject. SCABRIFOLIA, one spray not exceeding 12" from the top of the vase.
- Class 14. ANY 'HARDY' ELEPIDOTE SPECIES not catered for above, one truss or spray not exceeding 12" from the top of the vase.
- Class 15. ANY 'HARDY' LEPIDOTE SPECIES not catered for above, one truss or spray not exceeding 12" from the top of the vase.
- Class 16. ANY SPECIES AZALEA, deciduous or evergreen, one spray not exceeding 24" from the top of the vase.
- Class 17. ANY HYBRID, one truss.
- Class 18. ANY HYBRID, one spray, not exceeding 30" from the top of the vase. Exhibits over 24" in width will not on that account gain extra marks.
- Class 19. ANY TENDER SPECIES OR HYBRID including subgenus VIREYA (grown under glass or otherwise) one truss.
- Class 20. ANY TENDER SPECIES OR HYBRID including subgenus VIREYA (grown under glass or otherwise) one spray not exceeding 18" from the top of the vase.

Spring Ornamental Plants Competition

for the best exhibit will be presented.*

SCHEDULE

All entries should be from the open unless otherwise stated.

Entries in all classes must be no larger than 2½' x 2½'.

- Class 1. ANY THREE TREES OR SHRUBS OF DIFFERENT GENERA IN BLOOM,
(not a Rhododendron, Camellia or Magnolia), one vase of each.
- Class 2. ANY FOUR ORNAMENTAL PLANTS OF DIFFERENT GENERA IN BLOOM,
(not a Rhododendron, Camellia or Magnolia), one vase of each.
- Class 3. A TREE OR SHRUB IN BLOOM
(not a Rhododendron, Camellia or Magnolia), one vase.
- Class 4. A TREE OR SHRUB SHOWN FOR SPRING FOLIAGE
(new growth), one vase.
- Class 5. A TREE OR SHRUB SHOWN FOR ITS VARIEGATED FOLIAGE, one vase.
- Class 6. A CONIFER SHOWN FOR ITS FOLIAGE AND/OR CONES, one vase.
- Class 7. AN HARDY HERBACEOUS PLANT IN BLOOM
(other than a bulb), one vase.
- Class 8. ANY TREE OR SHRUB GROWN UNDER GLASS IN BLOOM
(not a Rhododendron, Camellia or Magnolia), one vase
- Class 9. ANY ALPINE IN FLOWER (other than bulbs), GROWN UNDER GLASS OR
OTHERWISE, one pot or pan not to exceed 10"
- Class 10. ANY FERN, one vase of fronds.
- Class 11. ANY EVERGREEN SHRUB NOT CATERED FOR ABOVE, in flower or not,
(not a Rhododendron or Camellia) one vase, no height restriction.
