There will be three general classes of Rhododendrons

There are seven species groupings. To cater for particular specialities there are classes for different groupings of species. Do not worry if you do not know what subsections yours belong to - someone will be on hand to help you. We will group them by subsection as follows: In each case one truss or spray from one species in the group

4. Arborea, Argyrophylla, Barbata, Glishra, Maculifera	8. Maddenia, Edgeworthia,
5. Campanulata, Fulgensia, Lanata, Grandia, Falconera	9. Triflora, Heliolepida, Cinnabarina, Tephropepla, Virgata
6. Fortunea	10. Laponica, Campylogyna, Saluenensia, Uniflora, Scabrifolia, Pogananthum, Lepidota, Neriiflora, Thomsonia, Selsensia, Campylocarpa, Williamsiana
7. Fulva, Irrorata, Parishia, Taliensia Pontica	

There are six classes for Camellias

11. Camellia japonica - any cultivar – 1 bloom	14. Camellia x williamsii - any 3 cultivars – 1 bloom of each
12. Camellia japonica - any 3 cultivars – 1 bloom of each	15. Camellia reticulata - any form or hybrid – 1 bloom
13. Camellia x williamsii - any cultivar – 1 bloom	16. Camellia - any other species – 1 bloom or spray

There are two classes for Magnolias

17. Any Magnolia species – one truss or spray	18. Any Magnolia cultivar – one truss or spray

Three other classes

19. Any Vireya Rhododendron - one truss or spray.	21. Any Azalea – one truss or spray.
20. Any Rhododendron or Azalea cultivar, raised from seed by the exhibitor – one truss or spray	22. Any Rhododendron, Camellia or Magnolia in a container
