1.	<i>C. japonica</i> , any cultivar, one bloom	
2.	<i>C. japonica</i> , any three cultivars, one bloom of each, 3 vases	
3.	<i>C. reticulata</i> , any cultivar or hybrid of which <i>C. reticulata</i> is a parent, one bloom	
4.	<i>C. x williamsii</i> , any cultivar, one bloom	
5.	<i>C. x williamsii</i> , any three cultivars, one bloom of each, 3 vases	
6.	Any six different camellias, one bloom of each, 6 vases	
7.	Any miniature camellia, one bloom (Miniature camellias are those whose normal sized blooms are less than 6cm (2½") across ie not uncharacteristically small blooms of a larger flowered variety.)	
8.	Any species or cultivar not included above	
9.	Three blooms of the same cultivar	
	Camellia Sprays and Vases Each spray or vase must not exceed 2½' in height from top of vase nor 2½' in overall width.	
10.	Any <i>C. japonica</i> cultivar, one spray	
11.	Any <i>C. x williamsii</i> cultivar, one spray	
12.	Any camellia, not eligible for classes 9 and 10, one spray	
13.	An arrangement of camellias shown for effect, one vase (normal competition vase)
